Young Swedish activist Greta Thunberg launched the “Let’s Move Humanity for Children in the Fight Against Coronavirus” global funding campaign that will provide support to UNICEF’s efforts to protect children in poor countries amid the Covid-19 pandemic.



Nadia Whittome, youngest MP in the UK Parliament, worked part-time as a care worker to help deal with the outbreak of the Novel Coronavirus while donating her salary to local Covid-19 support funds.



The European Parliament is housing 100 homeless women in one of its buildings in Brussels. Most of these women are victims of domestic abuse, thrown into the streets due to the lockdown. Now, these women have access to shelter, food and medical care.
