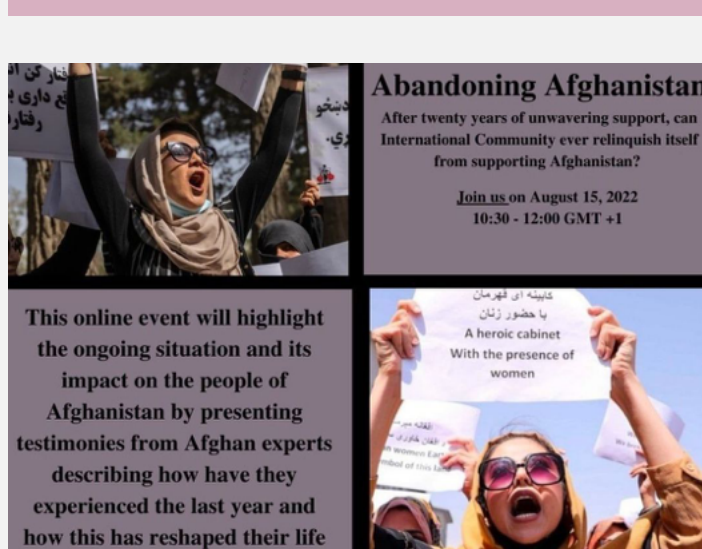


Frustration and Hope During the 2022 Protests

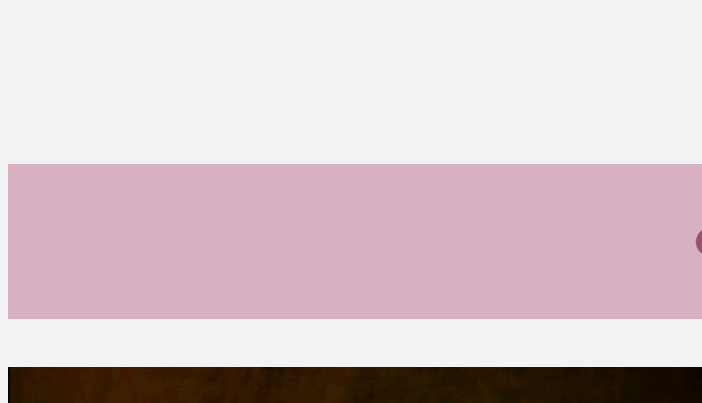


Ukraine: Statement of Solidarity

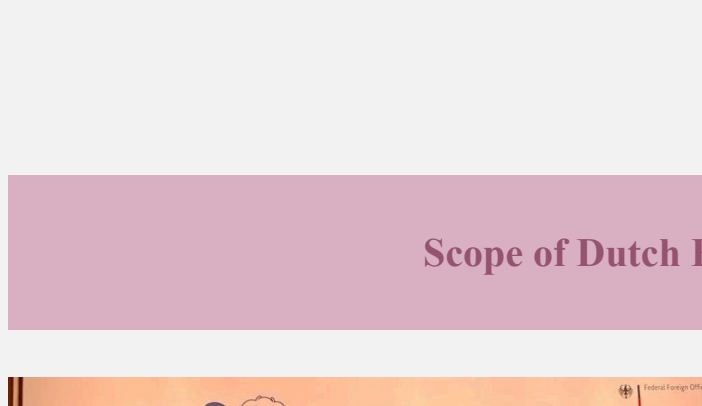


Another Year of Engagement
